# WHAT IS APOQUEL?

## WHAT IS THE ITCH CYCLE?


#### WHAT ARE CYTOKINES?

Cytokines represent a class of proteins that act as chemical messengers allowing cells to communicate with each other. These messengers can affect cell function and potentially lead to unwanted clinical signs and disease conditions, e.g., allergic dermatitis.


#### WHAT ARE JAK ENZYMES?

JAK enzymes reside in cells. When a cytokine binds to a cell receptor, the JAK enzymes are activated, leading to increased cytokine production. This action starts the cascade of itch.

### HOW DOES APOQUEL WORK TO BREAK THE ITCH CYCLE?



Apoquel inhibits the function of a variety of cytokines involved in itch. These cytokines are responsible for pruritus, inflammation and allergic responses.



Apoquel has minimal effect on JAK2-dependent cytokines involved in regulating the immune system and the production of new blood cells in the body.

# **APOQUEL VS. STEROIDS**

### WHY IS MY DOG RECEIVING THIS NEW THERAPY?

In the past, the most common treatment for skin diseases in dogs has been corticosteroids. They are effective initially but there are many potential side effects associated with long-term use.



#### **APOQUEL - A NOVEL APPROACH WITH FEWER SIDE EFFECTS**

Apoquel's side effect profile is similar to placebo and can be used with many common therapies including vaccines, NSAIDs, antibiotics and allergen immunotherapy (another common therapy for itching in dogs). Apoquel does not interfere with diagnostic testing, allowing your veterinarian to diagnose the underlying cause of itch.

### ONCE MY DOG'S ITCH HAS IMPROVED WITH APOQUEL, IS THE PROBLEM RESOLVED?

APOQUEL HELPS TO CONTROL YOUR DOG'S ITCH, BUT THE UNDERLYING CAUSE OF THE ITCH MAY BE UNRESOLVED.

### SPEAK TO YOUR VETERINARIAN ABOUT DIAGNOSING THE UNDERLYING CAUSE OF THE ITCH.

Because the side effects of Apoquel are similar to placebo - without many of the side effects associated with the use of steroids<sup>2-4</sup> – your veterinarian can continue to work on diagnosing the cause of your pet's itch while using Apoquel.

### TRACK YOUR DOG'S ITCH RELIEF WITH APOQUEL!

Keep track of your dog's itch once you start your dog on Apoquel. Using the Itch Tracker on the tear-off page, keep a record of how much your dog's itching has improved. **When** you return to the veterinarian, bring the chart and discuss the treatment results you have recorded. Be sure to mention if you noticed your dog's itch became worse again.




## HOW TO USE THE ITCH TRACKER

### TRACK YOUR DOG'S ITCH RELIEF WITH APOQUEL!

**WEEK 1:** For the first week, rate your dog's itching daily based on the itch rating definitions shown on the other side of this tear-off page.

**WEEKS 2-8:** Starting in the second week, rate your dog's itch only once a week, on the same day of the week.

Place a dot in the appropriate column aligned with the number and description that best describes the dog's itching. When the diary is completed, you and your veterinarian will see how your dog's itching has decreased over the course of treatment.



#### HOW TO RATE YOUR DOG'S ITCH

Dog is scratching, chewing, licking almost continuously. Itching practically never stops, regardless of what else is happening around the dog.

SEVERE ITCHING

Prolonged episodes of itching when the dog is awake. Itching occurs at night and also when eating, playing or exercising, or when otherwise distracted.

MODERATE ITCHING Regular episodes of itching when the dog is awake. Itching may occur at night and wake the dog. No itching when eating. playing, exercising or being distracted.

MILD ITCHING 40

Moderately frequent episodes of itching. There may be occasional episodes of itching at night. No itching when sleeping, eating, playing, exercising or being distracted.

VERY MILD 20 Occasional episodes of itching. The dog is slightly more itchy than before the problem began.

# HOW OFTEN DO I GIVE APOQUEL TO MY DOG?

#### YOUR VETERINARIAN HAS CHOSEN THE RIGHT DOSAGE AND FREQUENCY TO STOP THE ITCH, RIGHT NOW.

Apoquel is administered twice daily for up to 14 days, then once daily for maintenance. Your veterinarian may adjust these recommendations as needed.

Apoquel can be given with or without food.

You should see results within 4 hours of the first administration.
